All country delegations may have between 4 and 6 delegates (7 if the country is both in ECO and in SC). Each delegate is in a different committee.

Amnesty International, Greenpeace, Interpol, Palestine, World Bank and WTO are represented by 2 delegates each, Amnesty International and HRW in the Social and Humanitarian Committee, Greenpeace in the Environmental and Cultural Committee, Interpol in the Disarmament and International Security Committee, Palestine in the Political Committee, World Bank and WTO in ECOSOC. As they are not Members of the UN, they cannot vote, but they are very important for the discussion of various topics, and therefore their voice must be heard. They can sign and present resolutions.

The Security Council is an emergency organ. Delegates must be very well prepared and aware of the general situation of world politics as a crisis situation may occur which will need to be dealt with.
